Volunteer Role Description

ENGLISH TEACHER

Position:	English Teacher
Commitment:	Once a week for minimum 6 months
Start Date:	Sundays – September 7th Tuesday evening – End October

Task & Duties:

Teaching English to a group of approximately 15 migrant domestic workers
Keeping a register and regularly sending this to Kalayaan
Preparing lessons and teaching materials

Training provided:

There is no formal training for this role, Kalayaan will give a brief introduction to the client group at interview and teachers will be able to 'shadow' an experienced Kalayaan volunteer teacher. Volunteers are welcome to attend the training for advocacy support volunteers on 24th October if they wish to learn more.

Qualifications, Skills & Experience:

Volunteers should either be qualified in teaching ESOL, or be a qualified teacher, or have equivalent experience of teaching English. Consideration will be given to candidates with experience of teaching other subjects to adults.

Limitations of post:

Volunteers must not give immigration advice to their students. Any immigration related questions should be referred to Kalayaan.
