## Volunteer Role Description

ENGLISH TEACHER

<b>Position:</b>	<b>English Teacher</b>
<b>Commitment:</b>	<b>Once a fortnight for minimum 6 months</b>
<b>Start Date:</b>	<b>Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup> May</b>

### **Task & Duties:**

Teaching English to a group of approximately 15 migrant domestic workers  
Keeping a register and regularly sending this to Kalayaan  
Preparing lessons and teaching materials

### **Training provided:**

There is no formal training for this role, Kalayaan will give a brief introduction to the client group at interview and teachers will be able to 'shadow' an experienced Kalayaan volunteer teacher.

### **Qualifications, Skills & Experience:**

Volunteers should either be qualified in teaching ESOL, or be a qualified teacher, or have equivalent experience of teaching English. Consideration will be given to candidates with experience of teaching other subjects to adults.

### **Volunteer Expenses:**

Kalayaan can reimburse public transport expenses within London incurred in the course of the volunteer role. Receipts are required.

### **Limitations of post:**

Volunteers must not give immigration advice to their students. Any immigration related questions should be referred to Kalayaan.
