Position: Volunteer English Teacher.

Location: Kalayaan, 13 Hippodrome Place, W11 4SF London. This is not a remote

position.

Time commitment: 1.75 hours on a Sunday every other week, during the school term,

with no classes at half term.

Time: Lower class: 10am-11:40am; Higher class: 12:20pm-2pm.

Start date: As soon as possible.

About Kalayaan

Kalayaan is a London-based human rights charity that works to provide practical advice and support to, as well as campaign with and for, the rights of migrant domestic workers in the UK. Due to the under-regulated nature of domestic work and the very restrictive ODW visa, many workers are subject to abuse, control, non-payment of wages, and in the most extreme cases, human trafficking for domestic servitude.

As part of Kalayaan's commitment to improving the lives of domestic workers, we run English classes to enable our clients to communicate well, integrate into society, understand their rights and to feel more empowered. Typically migrant domestic workers work long hours and their only day off is on a Sunday, therefore these classes are also an opportunity for students to socialise.

Each class is taught by one teacher who is supported by one or two teaching assistants. Volunteers alternate on a weekly basis, so the commitment will be every other Sunday during school terms, with no classes at half terms. Lesson plans will be provided by the English class coordinator. However, volunteers are welcome to use

their own plans after liaising with the coordinator, or to adapt the plan provided as they wish.

We are particularly looking for volunteers with experience of teaching adults at a Pre-Entry level and of teaching adults who have limited literacy in their native language. The class levels range from Pre-Entry to roughly Entry Level 1.

Responsibilities

- Teaching English to a range of learners.
- Supporting individuals or groups of students to get the most out of their learning.
- Where needed, preparing materials and lesson plans in advance of lessons.
- Creating flyers and other notifications to recruit new students from our community of migrant domestic workers.

Qualifications, Skills & Experience

- A CELTA, TEFL or similar teaching qualification is necessary for the teaching role or relevant ESOL teaching experience.
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
- Reliable.
- Experience of teaching in an informal/community education setting.
- Be fluent in English.
- Confident and creative in interacting with people who speak English as a second language.
- Ability to work with colleagues and clients from different cultural backgrounds.
- Sensitive to the needs of clients who may be enduring extremely difficult personal circumstances, e.g. exploitative employment conditions, very long working hours, or who may previously have been enslaved or imprisoned.
- Commitment to equal opportunities.

Training and support provided

- Induction
- Ongoing training and support provided by the English Class Coordinator.

Limitations of post

Volunteer roles are unpaid, but we will reimburse volunteers for travel costs (public transport) within London (zones 1 to 6).

Unfortunately, we cannot sponsor candidates, and we cannot recruit volunteers on Visitor visas.
